

# Paediatric First Aid for Childcare Workers, Teachers & Carers

## Course Overview – 2 day course

- Febrile Seizures
- Asthma, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Meningitis,
- Poisoning
- Fractures and soft tissue injuries
- Burns & Scalds
- Course Assessment



On completion of the course participants will receive an **Advanta Safety Paediatric First Aid Certificate** and also a **Heartsaver CPR & AED Certificate (Irish Heart Foundation)**.

It is recommended that this is updated every two years.
