

Paediatric First Aid for Childcare Workers, Teachers & Carers

Course Overview – 1 day Course



This course is designed to give childcare workers, teachers, carers etc. the knowledge, skills and confidence to deal with all the common medical emergencies that can be encountered whilst caring for children and infants.

Duration: 1 Day (9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.)

- **CPR for Children and Infants**
- **How to react in an emergency situation**
- **Choking**
- **Bleeding & Wounds**
- **Dealing with an unconscious Child/Infant**
- **Febrile Seizures**
- **Asthma, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Meningitis,**
- **Poisoning**
- **Fractures and soft tissue injuries**
- **Burns & Scalds**
- **Course Assessment**



On completion of the course participants will receive an **Advanta Safety Paediatric First Aid Certificate**. It is recommended that this is updated every two years.
