

Health & Safety Representative's Course

Overview:

Under the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 employees may select and appoint from among their fellow employees, a Safety Representative. The Safety Representative's role includes consultation on workplace health & safety matters, workplace inspections, accident investigation, investigation of complaints etc.

This course has been developed to give Safety Representative's the skills and knowledge to fulfil their role effectively. This course will also help the Safety Representative to promote and maintain safety and health in the workplace and effectively represent employees on all health & safety issues that arise in the workplace.

Duration: 3 days.
